Reception

This week in Reception, our theme has been 'Whatever Next'. We've really enjoyed making up our own oral stories based on the 'Man in the Moon' book and designing and making junk model rockets with our friends. It was brilliant this week as we had a photo taken of us and inserted it into an astronaut picture with a sentence about where we're planning to travel to in Space.

Year 1

We've had such a fun week with our 'Spectacular Space' topic, using adjectives to create our own alien characters and write about an imaginary planet where they live. In Maths we've been revisiting position and direction and concentrating on writing and giving instructions to direct a rocket, using vocabulary such as half-turn, three-quarter turn and whole turn to describe their movement. In Music we've started to learn how to use a Boomwhacker.

Year 2

This week we've been writing to different chocolate companies to ask for information about their packaging designs and we've been starting to design our own packaging for a chocolate bar. In Maths, we've been learning about expanded addition and how to add tens and ones separately to aid their addition.

Year 3

We've continued to look at our text, 'Stig of the Dump' and have completed a 'slow write' description of Stig's cave trying to ensure we stopped to think before constructing sentences. It's been really interesting learning about Stonehenge and using this to start to create pieces of silhouette art based on this prehistoric monument. We've found telling the time on analogue clocks pretty challenging due to digital clocks being so commonplace and are going to practise this key skill at home. We are really looking forward to our school trip to the Earth Trust next Thursday.

Year 4

This week we linked our story of 'The Butterfly Lion' to the use of animals in a circus and spent time researching this. We then discussed and wrote about whether animals <u>should</u> be used in circuses. We had an amazing time on our trip to Fishbourne Palace on Wednesday and thoroughly enjoyed sharing some of our experiences with the rest of Key Stage 2 in Celebration Assembly. We had fun on World Book Day, as we were put into teams, named after BFG characters and had to answer Maths questions linked to Roald Dahl books.



Year 5

This week we started by focusing on Science Fiction Writing and researching the genre to make posters. We then looked at script writing using Dr Who as a stimulus. We have begun our 'Earth and Space' topic and have been investigating what we know about Earth in Space and why. In DT we've begun to design model rockets and are really looking forward to going to the London Science Museum in a few weeks' time. Mrs Edwards and her son Rhys took nine of us to a Tag Rugby Festival at The Hill yesterday afternoon. We warmed up by walking 'up the hill' and then played four games. We were a bit apprehensive as it was a Year 5/6 event and we're still Year 5 but we quickly settled into the games, supported brilliantly by Master Edwards and won two games, drew one and lost one. We were so pleased with our performance and so were Mrs Edwards and Master Edwards!
