We've had year group trips to the Earth Trust (Year 3), Winchester Planetarium (Year 1) and the London Science Museum (Year 5), Swimming lessons for Years 3 and 4 at Queen Anne's, Bikeability Level 1 for Year 4 and Level 2 for Year 5, Basketball, Netball, Football, Tag-Rugby and Cricket tournaments for Years 2-5, and a wonderful range of After School Clubs. ## Reception

This week we have been learning all about the Easter Story and how it's celebrated around the World. We've made Easter cards, written our own messages and decorated eggs in different ways. We've had so much fun in Maths, weighing the chicks and analysing the results, eg, is the oldest chick the heaviest and are the male chicks heavier than female chicks?

## Year 1

We've really enjoyed practising our money skills this week by setting up a 'shop'. We've also learnt to count and add British coins. Our new topic after Easter is Animals and in preparation for this we have focussed on new life, visited the chicks and completed still drawings of them. The children really enjoyed reading with each other and were extremely respectful of each other's work. The children said they felt proud when they were told their writing was "good, like a Year 2's" and "Your handwriting and story were very, very good." The experience was positive for both classes.

As well as completing different assessments this week, we've been learning about the Roman Invasion of Britain and practising mark-making in clay in preparation for making Beaker People inspired pots.

We loved our Bikeability course this week and are so much more confident on our bikes. Thank you to our instructors for all their patience and support. We also really enjoyed making models of our Roman structures out of junk modelling and showing them in assembly yesterday. In Maths we created bar graphs using a set of data and used them to convert between pounds and euros.

Year 5's trip to London involved us travelling by foot, tube and train. The children were wowed by the fantastic science they saw and enjoyed the hands-on activities a lot.
