IN THE CLASSROOMS



Year 1 have been creating fireworks poetry using all five senses and have made firework pictures using the wax-resistant technique and a colour wash. We have been consolidating their addition and have introduced subtraction using a number line. This afternoon we have experimented with joining skills and have made split-pin Pudsey bears.

The Reception classes have been writing about their homes, designing and building homes and exploring 3D shapes. Everyone is progressing with their Guided Reading. Reading Records and reading books will be sent home with Reception children next week.
