Dear Parents and Carers

It was great to welcome all the children back after half term. We really do miss them and all the fun, enthusiasm and joy they bring to school each day. Some of their reactions to seeing the new storey were wonderful. I wish I'd captured them on camera.

Reception

Reception have been 'firework-tastic' this week and have learnt the story of Guy Fawkes and Bonfire Night. They have been writing the onomatapaeic sounds fireworks make and creating fire safety posters. They have created wonderful pictures, learnt and performed a song and dance. In Maths they have been sorting and naming coins and starting to use 1p and 2p coins.

#### Year 1

This week Year 1 have been learning about Bonfire Night! We have been using onomatopoeia and writing sensory poems all about fireworks! In Maths we have been using time language and doubling and halving. We have also started to practise our Christmas songs...keep an eye out for costume requests...coming soon.

## Year 2

In Year 2 this week we have been reading the picture book *Dogs* by Emily Gravett and the information book *Looking after Dogs and Puppies*. We have talked about what these books have in common and noticed what is different about them. We have been writing facts about dogs and making posters to teach our classmates. In Maths we have been measuring objects in our classroom using decimetre strips; we know that 1dm is equal to 10cm; we started to measure in cm and metres. We can show you what a cm, dm and m look like. In Science we have learnt where wool comes from and used this to write a short information text.

We travelled back in time and learnt that the first people to have chocolate were the Aztecs and Mayans and know they lived long ago in a country that is now called Mexico. We know that Mexicans speak Spanish and we can sing a song in Spanish where we count up to ten! On Thursday we had a Bonfire Night themed day. We learnt a little about why we celebrate Bonfire Night and we learnt about how to be safe during Bonfire celebrations with a little help from Fireman Sam. We loved making some incredible firework art that we hope you enjoy at home too!
