Dear Parents/Carers

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
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Phonics this week: revise all digraphs/tricky words Learn how to blend and read CVCC (4 sound) words

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Our numbers this week are: 20-100 (or more)

This week we will be covering the following in our seven areas of learning:

Communication and Language	Retell the story of the 3 little pigs as an oral story/drama/role-play/puppet show
Personal Social and Emotional Development	How to be safe in the sun
Physical Development	Multi-skills PE session. Throwing and Catching PE session. Dough Disco and Finger Gym,
Literacy	Write in role-play using writing frames provided. Guided reading. Write a "sorry" letter from the wolf to the three little pigs. Child initiated writing of The Three Little Pig story
Mathematics	Investigate problems involving doubling. Correct formation of numerals
Expressive Arts and Design	Make pig collages/sketch pigs and wolves. Pig and wolf puppets and masks. Pantomimus Music session
Understanding the World	Investigate blowing pig houses down. Build a wolf proof house (large and small scale) and photograph it.  IT: PurpleMash paint project 3 Little Pigs, iBoard one scene focus, video our puppet show

Please support your child by encouraging them to practise saying the <u>NAME</u> of the letters in their phonics book, reading words on their blending cards and helping them to explore and read their school reading book. Approximately 10 minutes every day. Please record how they are getting on in their Reading communication diary.

You can also help your child with their learning this week by...... practising correct number formation and checking they can recognise and write numbers 11-20

## Parent and child challenge for the term!

Can you help your child to make a daisy chain as tall as themselves? Now try making a chain this length using the fewest number of daisies. Photograph what you have done and work with your child to display their results in a way they can show us as 'Show and Tell'. Have fun.
