This week we will be covering the following in our seven areas of learning:

Communication and Language	Take on roles, and speak in role in the indoor and outdoor learning environments. Show and tell - my pet. Listen and respond to what other say
Personal Social and Emotional Development	Friendship soup: what makes a good friend
Physical Development	Multi-skills PE session. Athletics: Javelin. Dough Disco and Finger Gym,
Literacy	Write in role-play using writing frames provided. Guided reading. Write a report about the farm visit. Make a non-fiction book about a pet. Read and spell polysyllabic words
Mathematics	Counting in 5's. Solving problems involving continuous addition Correct formation of numerals
Expressive Arts and Design	Design and make a junk model pet and pet home, painting and sketching pets Pantomimus Music session
Understanding the World	Investigate weather and keep a weather diary for class. Research how to look after pets using ipads

Please support your child by encouraging them to practise saying the **<u>NAME</u>** as well as the <u>SOUND</u> of the letters in their phonics book, reading words on their blending cards and helping them to explore and read their school reading book. Approximately 10 minutes every day. Please record how they are getting on in their Reading communication diary.

You can also help your child with their learning this week by ..... practising counting in 2's to 20

## Parent and child challenge for the term!

Can you help your child to make a daisy chain as tall as themselves? Now try making a chain this length using the fewest number of daisies. Photograph what you have done and work with your child to display their results in a way they can show us as 'Show and Tell'. Have fun.
