Literacy	Write in role-play using writing frames provided. Guided reading. Write an entry in Noahs ark log book. Write "Guess who" animal clues
Mathematics	Counting in 10's to 100. Correct formation of numerals
Expressive Arts and Design	Art and craft stimulated by theme of Noah's Ark Pantomimus Music session
Understanding the World	Investigate weather and keep a weather diary for class. IT. Gardening – planting out seedlings, plant vegetables, potatoes and herbs

Please support your child by encouraging them to practise saying the **NAME** of the letters in their phonics book (EG. for a... the name of the letter is /ai/ the sound is a as in apple), reading words on their blending cards and helping them to explore and read their school reading book. Approximately 10 minutes every day. Please record how they are getting on in their Reading communication diary.

You can also help your child with their learning this week by practising counting in 10's to 100

Parent and child challenge for the term!

Can you help your child to make a daisy chain as tall as themselves? Now try making a chain this length using the fewest number of daisies. Photograph what you have done and work with your child to display their results in a way they can show us as 'Show and Tell'. Have fun.
