Key Stage One Parent Planner: Summer 2 Week 1

Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is **Amazing Animals**

This week we will be:

English	This week we will be strongly focussing on letter formation to ensure the children are now able to form all letters cursively. For those children who have mastered this we will work on their joined up writing. The children will revisit the meaning of singular and plural and learn about suffix and prefix. We will also investigate what makes a super sentence!
Mathematics	In Maths we will be working on number bonds to 10 and 20, subtracting from a 1 or 2 digit number and LOTS of practical problem solving involving length, weight and time. We will also work writing numbers 1 to 20 in words.
Topic	This week we will begin to learn about the life of a significant individual. As our topic is Amazing Animals, we thought that there was no one more amazing that Sir David Attenborough.

Please support your child by encouraging them to read every night. It is extremely important to ask them lots of questions and ensure they understand the meanings of unfamiliar words.

This week, lots of your children will have the days of the week as their spellings. Please help them to practise these.

We would also be extremely grateful if you could work on writing numbers 1 to 20 in words with your children, the teen numbers are proving particularly challenging.

Please ensure your child has a hat every day. We realise the weather is unpredictable but as the children spend play and lunch times in the playground they need to be protected from the sun and from overheating. On sunny days, if they do not have a hat they are restricted to playing in the shaded part of the playground only.

Please ensure your child's **uniform and PE kits** are clearly labelled. We wasted a lot of time last term trying to sort out misplaced clothing and noticed that lots of it was not named. Thank you!
