This term our theme is: **Messing About On The River**

This week we will be:

English	This week we will be reading a range of poems all about rivers. We will be reading poems and exploring the language used in them. We will be learning our favourite poems off by heart and will be performing them with expression.
Mathematics	This week will be continuing to work on understanding word problems. We will also be working on understanding position and rotation. We will be exploring rotations as turns. We will be rotating objects and pictures of boats. We will be using the language of direction and position to describe what we have done.
Topic	<p>This week we will be going bonkers for boats! We will be designing, constructing and sailing boats made from a range of materials. We will be observing what materials make the best boats and exploring how to redraft and improve our designs. If you have any spare newspapers or plastic tubs at home, we would gratefully receive contributions to help with this design project.</p> <p>We will also be drawing inspiration from rivers for our artwork. Up the river from us, Henley will be celebrating its Royal Regatta this week. We will create artwork inspired by the regatta and looking at famous artwork depicting The River Thames.</p>

Please support your child by encouraging them to read every night. It is extremely important to ask them lots of questions and ensure they understand the meaning of unfamiliar words.

Your child will complete a spelling task every Monday. Please help your child to learn these spellings. It is beneficial for children to put their spelling words into sentences.
