This term our theme is: **All About Me** This week our theme is: **Faces**

This week we will be covering the following in our seven areas of learning:

Communication and Language	We are learning to talk with each other. Taking turns to speak and listen.
Personal Social and Emotional Development	Know about similarities and differences between themselves and others. Our first circle time. Learning the circle time rhyme and rules
Physical Development	Multi-skills PE session. Using our fingers and hands to shape facial features in playdough
Literacy	Listening for initial sounds in words. Orally blending 2 letter words using sounds we know eg. at, it,
Mathematics	Count and compare sets of objects and use vocabulary 'more than/less than'. Sort objects selecting own criteria and compare sets
Expressive Arts and Design	Make playdough faces. Make a collage face. Practise washing and dabbing our paint brush between colours when painting.
Understanding the World	Plan our role-play areas. Explore similarities and differences in our own faces and face images

Please support your child by practising the sounds in their phonics book, their blending card and helping them to explore and read their school sharing book every day for 5-10 minutes using the guide in their Reading communication diary.

You can also help your child with their learning this week by..... *Listen for the initial sounds in words. Comparing sets of objects and using vocabulary more than/less than*
