Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is: **Fire! Fire!**

This week we will be:

English	In English we will be focussing on sentence construction, ensuring the children are using capital letters and full stops with accuracy. The children will be visiting St Anne's Church and will be writing a recount of their visit as well as writing thank you cards.
Mathematics	In Maths we will be focussing on British coin recognition and telling and recording the time to the hour. Remember that we encourage the children to wear a watch to help them develop their time telling skills.
Topic	This week we will continue to investigate and compare fire fighters and their equipment in 1666 and in 2016. The children have also been exploring The Great Fire of London in our dance sessions and we will continue to do so this week.

Thank you for coming to our watch us at work session. It was lovely to see so many parents and I know the children enjoyed showing you their classrooms.

Just a reminder that all children must have a water bottle in school every day. We would politely ask that water bottles are **NOT** placed in book bags as several books have already been water damaged and this is avoidable.
