This term our theme is: Fire! Fire!

This week we will be:

English	This week we will be carrying some phonics assessments as well as spelling, grammar and punctuation tasks. We will also be continuing to practise our pre-cursive letter formation.
Mathematics	In Maths we will be focussing on 2d and 3d shape recognition and will be creating shape monsters. The children will need to identify the shapes they have used and talk about their properties. We will also work on recognising 3d shapes and will introduce the appropriate mathematical vocabulary: edges, vertices and faces.
Topic	The children will be designing a Tudor house, which they will create as a 3d model (using wood and a selection of tools!). In Geography we will explore the capital cities of the United Kingdom and learn to locate these on a map.
