Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is: **Fire! Fire!**

This week we will be:

English	In English we will continue to learn the event that took place during the great fire of London. The children will then put the events in order, write facts and at the end of the week produce their own newspaper reports!
Mathematics	In Maths we will be focussing on addition and subtraction calculations. The children will learn that when adding you can add the two numbers in any order but that this is not the case when subtracting. The children will also investigate how many ways they can make 10.
Topic	This week we will continue to investigate and compare fire fighters and their equipment in 1666 and in 2016. The children have also been exploring the great fire of London in our dance sessions and we will continue to do so this week.

Spellings will be tested today and every Monday thereafter. We will be discussing spellings at our KS1 meeting on Tuesday night and we hope you will be attending. If not and you have any questions, please do make an appointment to come and see us. We also have our watch us work session this Thursday afternoon, it's a great chance to come and see our classroom and what we have been doing so far!
