Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is **Dragons**.

This week we will be:

English	This week we will be changing parts of our 'dragon painter' story to include a different setting. We will how that will change our story. We will then plan and write our new version of the story.
Mathematics	In Maths this week, we will start by looking to solve problem involving measuring lengths. We will start by learning to measure larger lengths using meter sticks before moving onto learning how to measure accurately in cm. If we have time in the week we will move onto adding and subtracting simple lengths.
Topic	This week in Topic, we will reading 'The Paper Bag Princess' by Robert Munsch. We will be designing and making our own shields from junk modelling for the princess in the story. We will become scientists and first of all test out everyday materials so we can find the best ones to make our shield from. In PHSE we will be doing tasks based around anti-bullying. In RE we will be learning out Shabbat (the Sabbath) in Judaism.

The children in Year 2 have now started the Cracking Times Tables scheme. Every Monday they will have three minutes to answer times table questions. Each child should know exactly which tables they need to practise at home during the week. Help at home with this will enable them to be successful.

Please support your child by encouraging them to read at home every night. It is extremely important to ask them lots of questions and ensure they understand the meanings of unfamiliar words. Please record this in their record books that are collected in every day.
