English	This week we will be continuing our narrative work on our book Stone Age Boy. The children will be imagining what life was like for the girl Om and will be writing the events of the story from her perspective.
Mathematics	In maths we will continue to work on adding and subtracting, focussing on written methods for addition. We will work further on counting on to find the difference for subtraction.
Topic	We will be taking on the role of the hunter-gatherer by trying to locate and hunt down various Stone Age animals hiding in the school grounds! In art we will look at resistance painting techniques to create fossil-like images of Stone Age animals and in computing we will continue to create our information poster on our chosen animal.
