This term our theme is: **Detectives**

This week we will be:

English	Strange things are happening at The Heights at the moment. There have been some strange sightings around the school and over the next fortnight the children will be investigating these sightings and writing newspaper reports
Mathematics	This week the children will be learning about measures. They will focus on using mm, cm and m and will begin to convert between these measures. They will also start to look at statistics, considering how to record data in bar graphs.
Topic	We will think about what Stone Age people wore. We will focus on jewellery made of tusk and bone and we will be designing and making our own Stone Age jewellery using white clay. The children will also start their class cave art using the art skills learnt over the last few weeks.
