### Key Stage Two Parent Planner: Spring 2 Week 2

Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our theme is: **Detectives**

This week we will be:

English	This week we will be learning about shape poems. We will explore onomatopoeia and calligrams and we will be reading a range of different shape poems. We will aim to create our own shape poems about precious rocks, linking to our science topic. We will also celebrate <b>World Book day on Thursday</b> - don't forget to dress up and bring in the book too!
Mathematics	This week we will be developing our multiplication and division skills. We will do further work on the 4 and 8 times tables, looking at the relationship between the two. We will also focus on division being the inverse of multiplication and look at how we can use times tables to solve division questions with remainders.
Topic	This week we will explore how life changed at the start of the Bronze Age. We will investigate what it was like to be a Bronze Age child working in the mines. In D&T we will look more closely at Stone and Bronze Age beakers/pots focussing on the designs. We will have a go at imitating these designs and creating our own.

Please remember to bring **recorders** again this Wednesday.

Following the work we did on 'time' last week in maths, we are hoping to continue telling the time through the week, so if your child has a watch, please remind them to put it on. It would be great if you could practise time skills at home, particularly telling time to the hour (E.g. ten to five).

As the field can be very muddy, it would be useful if children could have a spare carrier bag to put their trainers in after PE.
