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This week we will be:

English	This week we are going to be learning what makes a good
	setting description. We will start by listening to a setting
	description from the Aztec city of Tenochtitlan before drawing
	our own setting description. We will then look at the
	vocabulary that is in a setting description and finding out
	what any new words mean. At the end of the week we will be
	writing our own setting description about Tenochtitlan.
Maths	This week we will start by learning about the properties of 2D
	and 3D shapes. Then towards the end of the week we are
	looking at measuring lengths and ordering them.
Science	This week is Science week! We will be having a go at some
	fantastic experiments including finding out if custard is a
	liquid (no spoilers please!), and we will also be finding out
	the importance of camouflage in nature. We will then be making
	a poster to enter it into the British Science Week competition and
	showing our work in the Friday assembly.

The children in Year 2 have now started the Cracking Times Tables scheme. Every Monday they will have three minutes to answer times table questions. Each child should know exactly which tables they need to practise at home during the week. Help at home with this will enable them to be successful.

Please support your child by encouraging them to read at home every night. It is extremely important to ask them lots of questions and ensure they understand the meanings of unfamiliar words.
