Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is: **Amazing Animals**

This week we will be:

English	In English this week we will be discussing what we would like to learn during our Amazing Animals topic. We will write down some questions and use question marks accurately. We will also continue to work on singular and plural, focussing on singular and plural animals for example - fox and foxes. Then we will work on using the prefix 'un' and the suffixes 'ing' 'ed' and 'er' in our writing.
Mathematics	In Maths this week we will be measuring and recording the height and length on animals using standard and non-standard forms of measure. We will also explore and interpret some data in table form and discuss and record our findings.
Topic	We will be introducing our new topic this week. We will be exploring animal art from around the world over the next term and will start with aboriginal art this week! We will also be talking about the 7 continents of the world and will learn a song to help us. We will also identify animals that can be found on each of the continents.

We hope you had a great Easter break. It was wonderful to welcome the children back today and hear all about their adventures. We are all looking forward to fun filled term with the children.

As we enter in to the final term of the year we will begin to gently prepare the children for Year 2. When the children come in to school in the morning they will complete a morning activity, which they will continue to do throughout their time in Year 2.
