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This term our theme is: Amazing Animals

This week we will be:

English	In English this week we will be focussing on story language and retelling traditional tales. We will share the story of The Enormous Turnip and act it out with and without props. We will also order the story and write it in our English books, using story language.
Mathematics	In Maths this week we will be adding, subtracting and solving calculation problems. We will use an unstructured number line to add and will work on learning our subtraction facts from 20.
	We will also continue to practise counting in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.
Topic	In Science this week, we will be exploring the structure of a variety of animals and learning about different animal parts. We will also create a bar chart to determine which of the six groups our favourite animal belongs to.
	In RE we will continue to learn about Judaism. This week we will investigate the features of a synagogue.
	In History we will find out about the legend that is Sir David Attenborough, who celebrated his 91 st birthday on Monday!
