This week we will be:

English	This week we will be completing an assessed piece of writing. We will be researching and note taking and then organising our notes into a plan for writing. It will be a chance for the children to show off their fantastic writing skills!
Mathematics	In maths this week we will be fine tuning our measuring skills, collecting data and presenting our work into bar charts. We will also learn about perimeter and apply our measuring skills to calculate the perimeters of shapes. We will finish the week looking at time. The children will focus on telling the time to the nearest minute so please help the children to practise this at home.
Topic	We will be making some preparations for our visit to the Wind Turbine next week.
