Dear Parents/Carers

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This week our themes are:

Living Things and their Habitats and Maps

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English	The children will be exploring different types of persuasive
	writing and investigating the strategies used to persuade. They
	will be creating a persuasive advert for Longridge and they
	will also be writing a letter to persuade loggers against
	deforestation.
Maths	The children will continue to revise and consolidate their
	knowledge of place value. They will solve problems using their
	knowledge of place value and number bonds. They will begin
	to explore decimal numbers making links to money to gain a
	greater understanding of the value of tenths and hundredths.
Topic	Last week we did an invertebrate hunt and were amazed by
	how many different species we found on our school site. We
	even found same snails eggs! We will begin to design our
	own classification keys for Living Things.
	Following on from our orienteering activity at Longridge we
	will be looking at the Longridge map and using directional
	vocabulary to describe where things are. We will then look at
	the physical features of Guatemala using a map.

Our spellings have been going really well, thank you for helping the children to revise their spellings at home and bring their books in every day.

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We are still in the process of establishing a good routine for our Cracking Times Tables. We will test the children on their tables on a Friday and will aim to have the books marked and sent home again on Friday. However, there may be occasions when our resources do not allow us to turn the books around that quickly, please bear with us. We have talked about it in class and have decided that the children should not be writing on the test sheet at home. As with spellings the children may revise their tables in whichever way is best for them and can use the pages in their times tables books if they want to but may prefer to use separate sheets of paper or websites.
