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	This term our theme is Dragons .
English	This week the punctuation police are in town! They are
	looking for criminal offences with our capital letters and
	full stops. Over the rext week we will be recapping how
	and when to use capital letters and full stops and
	correcting work which hasn't shown any. Later in the
	week we will be learning about proper nouns and when
	we reed capital letters for them.
Mathematics	In maths this week we are learning how to add a one
	digit number to a 2 digit number. We will start by doing
	number sentences on a bead string before moving onto
	doing it on a number track (similar to number line).
	Later in the week we will be learning to solve problems
	involving length and quantity.
Topic	This week in Topic we will be starting to look at
	different habitats from around the world and identify
	some animals that have adapted to survive to their
	habitat.
Art	In art we will be sketching and labelling a hydra
	dragon to go with our non-chronological report for
	professor Kent.
