Dear Parents/Carers

This week our themes are:
Guatemala including rainforest sounds

English	The children will be finding out about CS Lewis and starting to read <i>The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe</i> . They will be using the story as inspiration to create their own imaginary and unusual place, animal or object and writing a description of this.
Maths	The children will continue to revise and consolidate their knowledge of place value and some children will begin to explore decimal numbers. They will be using their knowledge of place value, number bonds and the commutative law to estimate and solve problems.
Topic	The children will begin to explore what it is like to live in Guatemala, what religions are practised in Guatemala and how Guatemala is changing. In music the children will be exploring rainforest sounds and composing their own rainforest inspired piece of music.
