This week our themes are: The Mayans / Anti-bullying / UK Parliament

English	Linking to our History (Mayans) and R.E. (creation
	stories) topics the children will be reading The Mayan
	Creation Story. They will investigate the story by
	sequencing pictures and by summarising the story in 6
	key sentences which they will then add actions to.
	Towards the end of the week the children will plan and
	begin to write their own versions of The Mayan Creation
	Story which they will then complete and publish next
	week.
Maths	The children will complete their learning on addition and
	subtraction by using RUCSAC to solve word problems.
	They will then begin to revise the link between
	multiplication and division. Towards the end of the
	week the children will be multiplying 3-digit and single
	digit numbers using the grid method.
Topic	Our Mayan focus this week will be on religion and
	Gods. The children will be researching religious rituals
	and practices and then producing a mini presentation to
	share with the class. They will then create a facts sheet
	on Mayan Gods.
	Our PSHE topic this half term is Celebrating Differences.
	However, this week is anti-bullying week and also UK
	parliament week so we will be having extra PSHE time to
	focus on both of these extremely important topics.
	The children will continue to build Lego by following
	instructions on the iPad. They will then link their Milo
	to the iPad and make him move by giving him
	instructions.
