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This week our themes are: The Mayans

English	The children will be finishing their versions of The Mayan Creation Story which they will then publish to go on display. In the grammar part of the lesson, children will continue to focus on fronted adverbials for starting sentences.
Maths	We will build on last week's investigations into
	multiplication and division. The children will be
	multiplying numbers using the grid method. They will
	then start to look at methods for division.
Topic	In PSHE we will continue to focus on 'Celebrating
	Differences' and 'Anti-Bullying' with a focus on indirect
	bullying, for example leaving someone out or whispering
	about them.
	The children will continue to build Lego by following
	instructions on the iPad. They will then link their Milo
	to the iPad and make him move by giving him
	instructions.
	Last week Shams, one of our year I parents, led a
	fascinating talk about being a Muslim. The children
	were all really interested and quite surprised about how
	similar Islam is to Christianity and Judaism. We hope
	to do a follow up lesson this week with a focus on the
	similarities between religions.
	We will be exploring a Mayan timeline but also looking
	at where Ancient Maya fits in on a world history
	timeline. In addition, the children will be learning about
	Mayan food, building up to making their own tortillas
	with a filling of their choice!
	In music the children will begin to write their own
	Mayan song.
