This week our themes are:
The Mayans

English	<p>This week we will be inspired by the John Lewis advert and will be writing stories about Moz the monster. In grammar, we will be focussing on the correct use of 'was and were' and will also be revising nouns and pronouns.</p>
Maths	<p>To spread out the end of term assessments we will be doing our Maths assessments this week and the English assessments next week. The children will spend the first half of the week revising key concepts from over this half term.</p>
