This term our theme is: **All About Me** This week our theme is: **My House**

Our sounds/tricky words this week are: **revise all digraphs** and the words: **my, was, this, went**

Our numbers this week are: **11-20**

This week we will be covering the following in our seven areas of learning:

Communication and Language	Talk about our ideas regarding "My House". Listen and respond to others' ideas. Negotiate plans with peers in order to build a den.
Personal Social and Emotional Development	What to do if you get lost. The importance of staying with an adult when you are out and about.
Physical Development	Multi-skills PE session. Dough Disco and Finger Gym, using our pincer grip to pick up small items and place them accurately. Letter/number formation handwriting practise
Literacy	Write a description of your house. Segment CVC words. Write common exception words. Read simple sentences
Mathematics	Become familiar with Numicon equipment. Explore and say the number that is one more or one less than a given number
Expressive Arts and Design	Choose and combine media and techniques in order to design and make a house. Collaborate on a large scale street scene
Understanding the World	Find out about different types of homes

Please support your child by practising the sounds in their phonics book, their blending card and helping them to explore and read their school reading book every day for 5-10 minutes using the guide in their Reading communication diary.

You can also help your child with their learning this week by..... *Exploring one more than and one less than a given number*
