English	This week, we will continue to look at the book Stone Age
	Boy. We will be story mapping and boxing up a hunt and

Mathematics	In maths we will be adding and subtracting pairs of two
	digit numbers using different strategies. We will be
	subtracting multiples of 10 and near multiples and using
	counting up to find the difference.
Topic	We are continuing with our Stone Age topic and will be

	about survival in the Stone Age. We will be looking at the
	challenges early man faced and discovering how tools

	we will be sketching animals using chalks and charcoal to
