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| English | This week we will be continuing with our own pieces of descriptive writing based on a Stone Age hunt and celebration, using our class success criteria to help us. We will be using powerful language and imagery to engage the reader and create tension and excitement. |
| Mathematics | In maths this week, we will be using expanded and compact column addition to add together two and three digit numbers and column subtraction to subtract two digit numbers from three digit numbers. |
| Topic | We will be discovering how humans in the Stone Age collected their food. We will be hunting for our own food and thinking about which weapons will help us to gather. In art we will be looking at fossils of animals and plants, discussing how they were formed and thinking about what we can learn from them. We will then go on to explore different mark making methods to create our own animal imprints. |
