This term our theme is: **Spectacular Space**

Over the following week we will be:

English	This week we will be finishing our Non-Fiction Space Booklet. The children will learn more about Non-Fiction Books by writing their own index page and contents page. They will also check their work and spot any Marvellous Mistakes they have made. We will also be planning and writing a short Space story this week using our class book 'Cakes in Space' for inspiration.
Mathematics	We will be learning about division this week. The children will learn how to divide by sharing and grouping. On Friday they will use what they have learnt to work out some word problems.
Topic	In Computing we will be using the I pads to play a maths sequencing game. In Art the children will continue to use their observational skills to create a watercolour painting of a daffodil. The children will also be designing and creating a space rocket from cardboard tubes. In our Science lesson this week we will be investigating different plants.
