Dear Parents/Carers

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This term our theme is: Spectacular Space

This week we will be...

English	We will be focussing on the book 'Here come the aliens' by Colin
0	McNaughton. The children will create their own alien and use adjectives to
	describe it. They will then make an alien family for their alien using
	capital letters to write their names. Then they will draw a planet for their
	alien to live on and write about it using adjectives and commas.
	The children will continue to work on their handwriting making sure that
	their letters are on the line and of a similar size.
Mathematics	We will be learning to name and order the days of the week and months
	of the year this week. The children will learn a new song to help them
	remember the months of the year. We will also be sequencing daily
	routines.
Topic	In Geography we will be learning the names of the seven continents by
	singing 'The Continents Song'. In our PSHE Jigsaw lesson we will be
	learning more about Healthy Eating and drawing ourselves a healthy
	balanced meal. During our Computing lesson we will be using our new
	Chrome books for the first time. The children will learn to log on and find
	out about the Google Classroom.

PE Kit – We still have a few items missing in some children's PE Kits. Please make sure they have everything they need. (Long warm jogging bottoms, **PE socks**, PE T-shirt, PE jumper and trainers (That have as much of the mud removed as possible)

Reading at home - Please continue to read every day at home with your child and record this in your child's Reading Record. It's important that your children are regularly practising their comprehension, fluency and expression as well as decoding words.

Maths at home – Please can you practise counting in 2's up to 20, 5's up to 50 and 10's up to 100 with your child at home.
