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This week our themes are:

Romans and Sound

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English	The children will be exploring Roman myths and writing
	their own versions using fronted adverbials and thinking
	about dialogue. Next week they will write their own
	myth.
Maths	The children will be revising and consolidating their
	learning on measure including:
	 solving problems involving money;
	 measuring accurately with a ruler to the nearest
	mm;
	 converting between 12 hour and 24 hour times;
	 solving time problems.
Topic	In topic the children will be learning about Hadrian's
'	wall including what life for a Roman soldier at the wall
	would have been like.
	We continue to press on with our mosaics in Art, they
	are really coming together now.
	Last week in Science the children explored sound, we did
	some class role play to act out how sound travels from
	its source to our ear and then to our brain. This week
	we will continue to develop our learning on sound
	vibrations and will develop our understanding of pitch
	and volume. We will start to think about how we could
	make our own musical instrument.
	Our focus in PSHE continues to be Healthy Me. Last
	week the children explored friendship and identified
	friends as contributing to us having a healthy mind.
	This week we will develop this further.
