	This week our themes are: Weather
English	In English the children will finish writing their own
	poem 'Weather Watcher: A Journey Across the World.'
	They will also start their new book- ' <i>The Giant's</i>
	Necklace' by Michael Morpurgo.
Maths	In Maths the children will be exploring the properties of
	3d shapes- focusing on naming the shapes and counting
	the edges, vertices and faces. They will spend the rest of
	the week exploring coordinates as they plot these onto a
	grid. At the end of the week the children will create
	their own board games using their knowledge of position
	and direction.
Topic	The children will continue with their new topic 'Wild
	Weather' as they receive a visit from Professor Brugge
	from Reading University's meteorological department. He
	will show the children some of the equipment used to
	interpret the weather. In computing the children will use
	an Excel document to input the week's temperature and
	create a graph based on this information.
	In Science the children will be investigating gases. They will learn what gas is in a fizzy drink and hypothesise
	whether a fizzy, or flat drink, weighs more.
	In R.E. this week we will focus on what the word holy
	means as we explore the holy texts of Hinduism and
	learn about the story of Rama and Sita.
