Dear Parents/Carers

This week our theme is: **Weather**

English	In English the children will be reading 'The Giant's Necklace' by Michael Morpurgo. The children will be writing the opening to the story and will give background information to the reader. They will be writing paragraphs with relevant openings and will use a variety of techniques to develop characters.
Maths	In Maths the children will be revising their learning on Geometry. They will be drawing shapes with different areas including squares, rectangles, triangles and trapeziums. The children will make non-symmetrical shapes symmetrical by adding parts to them. They will continue to make links between degrees of turn, fractions and decimals.
Topic	Following on from our visit from Dr Brugge the children will be cracking weather codes and also creating pressure lines on a map. In Science the children will continue to learn about states of matter. Last week in P.E. the children built on skills learnt at their dance workshop on 'The Butterfly Lion' and began to create a 'Weather' dance. This week they will continue to develop this dance. In R.E. this week we will focus on the Sikh holy book 'Guru Granth Sahib.'
