Dear Parents/Carers

This term our theme is: **Amazing Animals**

This week we will be...

English	We will continue to use the story of 'The Enormous Turnip' this week and will be making their own changes to the story to create their own version. They will change the story by thinking of new characters and settings and plan their new story on a story map. The children will spend two days writing their new stories and share them with IAP/IVH on Friday.
Mathematics	We will be revisiting addition this week and will be learning some new skills that might help us. We will learn how to use number lines and number grids to support our addition. On Friday the children will be solving missing number problems.
Topic	In Science this week we will be learning about the human body and labelling the different parts. The children will be creating their own junk model animal in Art and decorating it in their own way with different resources. In Computing this week we will continue to use the Chromebooks to learn how to use our own individual log ons and use Google Classroom to answer questions.
