This week our themes are: **Newspapers**

English	In English this week we will be continuing with our work on newspaper articles. We will link this to topic as we write an article about the Boscastle floods in Cornwall. Last week we researched facts on the Chrome books about the floods to include in our article.
Maths	In Maths the children will be continuing with their work on statistics. We will look at line graphs and revise our knowledge of bar graphs.
Topic	<p>In Science we will be finishing our topic 'states of matter'. Our last lesson will look at evaporation as we explore different ways to make material dry quicker.</p> <p>Last week in PSHE we started our 'changing me' topic, as discussed in the meeting for parents led by Mrs Edwards and Mrs Fallon, this will cover elements of relationships and sex education.</p> <p>A large part of last week was setting ground rules for these sessions which aim to promote good listening, sensible discussions and respect for each other's thoughts and opinions.</p> <p>We introduced a question box that children can use should they have any questions that they do not wish to ask in front of the others. The children discussed the changes that babies go through as they turn into children and later adults.</p> <p>This week we will explore the changes that take place inside the womb prior to a baby being born. We will also focus on the body changes that occurs to children as their bodies prepare them for the possibility of making babies when they are older.</p>
