Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our theme is Superstructures.

English	This week we will be finishing our persuasive writing unit. We will be completing and publishing our own persuasive letters, thinking about the key language features that we need to include in our work. At the end of the week we will be assessing the children's spelling and grammar knowledge.
Mathematics	In maths this week we will be assessing the children's multiplication and division knowledge before going on to look at fractions. We will be reading and writing fractions and counting in halves, quarters and tenths. Later in the week, will be going on to compare fractions and add fractions to make a whole
Topic	In our topic work this week, we will be locating different UK superstructures, using our grid reference skills to help us locate the towns and cities in which they can be found. In art we will finishing our templates to use in our own superstructure prints.

PE for Year 3 this term will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons. We are happy for kits to come in on a Monday and go home on a Friday. If your child comes home in their PE kit, please can you ensure it comes back in the next day particularly if they have after school clubs (it doesn't need to be washed, just bagged up).
