This week our theme is **Romans**

English	This week the children will complete the remainder of the English assessments. They will then begin to start reading their next text 'The Butterfly Lion.' This is another text by author Michael Morpurgo and the children will be making comparisons to 'Kensuke's Kingdom.'
Maths	This week, the children will be revising fractions and decimals and will then complete a mental maths and written maths assessment.
