Dear Parents/Carers

We are racing towards Easter! Last week the children thoroughly enjoyed their football tournament and Science week. Unfortunately, the first aid training was postponed but has been re-booked for May.

English	After several weeks with a focus on persuasive letters and discussion
	texts, the year four will end the term with some fictional writing based on
	Roman myths. They will be taking part in reading and drama activities
	before writing the myths in their own words. The children will use this
	opportunity to revise expanded noun phrases, adverbs, adjectives,
	fronted adverbials with commas and inverted commas for dialogue.
Maths	The topic for the last two weeks of term is statistics. The children will
	be creating and using pictographs, bar graphs, line graphs and
	timetables.
Topic	This week in Science, the children will be planning and carrying out an
	investigation into the best material to use for soundproofing. They will
	consider their independent, dependent and control variables.
	The children will be using their last few topic lessons to revise and
	consolidate their learning on the Romans and to finish off their Google
	slide presentations, mosaics and Fishbourne Palace leaflets.
	In French, the children will be revising and consolidating instructions,
	body parts and colours.
	In R.E. the children will continue to explore the Easter story.
	In PSHE, the children will continue to explore being healthy.

Just a reminder that next week the children will have their Bikeability cycle sessions. Please see separate email for details as to which day they will be having their cycling session. On the morning of their cycling session, children will need to bring bikes and helmets to school. These must not be left in the usual bike racks as the instructors need to check that they are roadworthy. Mrs Edwards has asked that bikes be left by the fence adjoining St Anne's school field.
