This term our theme is **Stone Age Rocks!** This week we will be:

English	This week we will be continuing to look at our text, Stig of the Dump. We will be boxing up chapter 1, looking at the key parts of it and thinking about key vocabulary that is, and could be, included in the chapter. At the end of the week, we will be completing a 'slow write' description of Stig's cave, ensuring we are stopping to think before constructing a sentence.
Mathematics	In maths this week, we will be continuing to work on time. We will be focusing on digital time and the 24-hour clock. We have found children find telling the time on analogue clocks particularly challenging due to digital clocks being so common place. It would therefore be fantastic if you could ensure you are practising this key skill at home as much as possible.
Topic	In topic, we will be learning about Stonehenge before going on to create pieces of silhouette art based on this prehistoric monument. In science, we will be looking at how fossils occur and sequencing the fossilisation process.
