This term our theme is **Stone Age Rocks!**

English	This week we will be continuing to look at our text, Stig of the Dump. We will be writing our own version of chapter 1 focussing on including adverbial phrases to describe time, reason, manner and place.
Mathematics	In maths this week, we will be completing an assessment to demonstrate everything we have learnt about time before going on to look at interpreting pictograms with different scales. On Wednesday, we will be revising methods of column addition and subtraction.
Topic	In topic, we will be looking at the Bronze Age and Iron Age and how they differ to the Stone Age and learning about roundhouses and hillforts. In science, we will be looking at what soil is made up of!

This Thursday, we have our school trip to The Earth Trust.
