Dear Parents/Carers

English	This week is assessment week. Over the course of the week, the children will be completing two reading assessments and a grammar assessment. Writing has already been assessed separately.
Maths	This week the children will be creating their own bar graphs using a set of data provided for them. They will then be using conversion graphs to convert between pounds and euros. Once they are ready, the children will complete their statistics assessment.
Topic	Children across year four will be taking part in the Bikeability sessions from Monday through to Thursday.
