Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our theme is **To Infinity and Beyond!**

I can't believe that this term is almost over. We have had a really fun term learning and having lots of fantastic experiences and the children have earned a break. We have such a busy last week. I have split the Parent Planner into days so you can see what we will be doing.

Monday	On Monday, we will be doing the last 2 assessments of the term, Maths and SPAG. In the afternoon, we will finishing off our Healthy Me topic by considering Body Image and Food.
Tuesday	<p>On Tuesday, we will be watching <i>A Wrinkle in Time</i> which is an adaptation of the book we have been doing in Whole Class Reading. The children have been really persevering with it, especially as it is a tough book which many children wouldn't have chosen themselves. The film is a PG. If anyone has any concerns about the film then they can speak to me beforehand. We will also be having popcorn as an end of term treat. If you would prefer your child didn't have popcorn, then please do let me know.</p> <p>We will also be having a talk about our trip taking place on Wednesday. I will be briefing the children on the timetable and the safety procedures. This will also be a great time for the children to ask any questions they might have about the trip.</p> <p>We will also do Cracking Times Tables for the last time this term. In the afternoon, Geography and PE will be as usual.</p>
Wednesday	<p>On Wednesday, we will be going on our trip to the London Science Museum. We will leave school at 9:00 and children will be allowed into the classroom at 8:30 to make sure they're ready and have had a chance to go to the toilet. Children will be wearing school uniform and shuld bring a lunch (unless being provided by crumbs), a bottle of water and a snack. It may rain so a waterproof coat may be necessary. Our train arrives into Reading Station at 15:36 and we should be back in school for pick up at 16:00.</p> <p>Just a reminder, if you haven't paid for the trip can you please do so on Parent Pay ASAP.</p>
Thursday	<p>On Thursday, we will be doing a piece of writing about our trip in the Morning.</p> <p>PE will be as usual in the afternoon.</p>

Friday	<p>Friday is a half day with the usual assembly and end of term activities. We will also have our half termly class meeting where the children can say what they have enjoyed this term and what they would like to do more of next term.</p> <p>If children would like to bring in a board or card game they can, but please ensure it has a name written on it or I will write it on the box myself.</p>
