

Mathematics

Over this term, children will be solving problems involving shape, angles and measurement. We will be using protractors to measure angles in shapes, as well as the reasoning skills to solve problems about missing angles or lengths. We will be playing lots of games to ensure all children are able to visualise the shapes, sizes and angles they're working with. We are also lucky to have time to revise and recap work that has been done previously.

PSHE

This term we are considering Relationships which includes friends, family and boyfriends/girlfriends. Afterwards, we will be thinking about Changes. This will include changes that the children will go through in adolescence. We will also be learning about conception.

English

Linked to our topic, we will be doing lots of work to compare and contrast effectively using adverbials for cohesion. Using these skills, we will be debating, just like the Ancient Greeks did. We will be having a poetry competition where children will be learning poems over half term. We will be building on our writing and performing skills by studying Aesop's Fables, A Midsummer Night's Dream and various other Greek Myths.

History

We are looking at the legacy that the Ancient Greeks have left us including Culture, Sports, Architecture and also the fantastic Myths, gods and war stories.

Geography

We will be comparing the Greek islands with those of the Caribbean in North America. We will be researching and comparing physical and human features, consolidating all of the work we have done this term.

Art/DT

In Art, we will be designing and creating 2D Greek Vases.

P.E.

In PE we will be doing lots of Athletics practise before Sports Day, honing our jumping, running and throwing skills. After half term, we will be developing striking and fielding skills in Rounders and Cricket.

Religious Education

This term, children will be thinking about Commitment with a focus on comparing different religions. We will be thinking about sacrifice and fasting, as well as what religious milestones some people go through.

French

In French, we will be learning about school vocabulary. This will involve talking and writing and even having a maths lesson in French.

Science

In the first half term, we will be considering Living Things and Their Habitats. This will include sexual and asexual reproduction of plants and also different life cycles. We will be exploring this as botanist and zoologist illustrators, capturing what we investigate in art/drawings.

In the second half term we will be thinking more about Animals including Humans while considering the Human Life cycle including adolescence and puberty. This topic is linked to PSHE in which we will be learning about conception.

Computing

This term we are doing research around Ancient Greece and continuing work on word processing. We will also be exploring spreadsheets.

Music

We will be learning the rap from The Fresh Prince of Bel Air whilst considering rhythms in order to compose our own raps.
