Year 4 Parent Planner: Summer 1 Week 3
Topic- Wild Weather

Dear Parents/Carers,

English	This week the children will start their new class story- 'The Giant's Necklace' by Michael Morpurgo. They will start by ordering a sequence of pictures and writing a short story based upon these. We will consider how suspense is built up in a piece of writing and the children will have the opportunity to look for examples of suspense in our story.
Maths	This week the children will translate shapes on a grid and describe the movement of these shapes. They will also explore different angles, looking at the properties of these angles and sorting shapes into a venn diagram. Towards the end of the week we will describe and sort a variety of triangles and quadrilaterals.
Topic	<p>This week in topic, we will review some of our learning from Professor Brugge's visit. We will look at weather codes and learn how to read these.</p> <p>In French the children will review their knowledge of the French seasons before learning more weather vocabulary.</p> <p>In RE, the children will look at Sikhism as they consider what ways Sikh's show respect when they read the Granth Sahib.</p>

As the weather is still varied we ask that children bring waterproof coats into school for inclement days.

This term, as part of our Wild Weather topic, we are planning a trip to West Wittering beach. The trip will take place on Friday 21st June and a separate parent mail will be sent nearer the time with more details.

To raise money for our trip to West Wittering beach in June both 4CT and 4RR will be raising money by holding a cream tea sale. The children will make scones in school and will sell these after school. 4CT will hold their sale on Wednesday 15th May and 4RR on Monday 20th May.
