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| English | This week the children will finish reading 'The Giant's Necklace' by Michael Morpurgo. They will look at descriptive writing before writing their own description of the dark cave Cherry climbs through. Towards the end of the week we will look at the author's purpose for writing and consider whether it was to persuade, inform or educate the reader. We will also re-cap how suspense is built within the story. |
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| Maths | This week the children will continue with their geometry topic as they name, describe and sort a variety of quadrilaterals. We will also look at lines of symmetry before drawing a reflected shape. Towards the end of the week, we will consolidate our knowledge of angles. |
| Topic | This week in topic, we will learn about Cornwall and investigate the effects of the weather on the county. We will also look at the geography of the county as we consider the human and physical features of Cornwall. |
| | In French, the children will continue to review their knowledge of weather vocabulary as they practice using these words within a sentence. |
| | In RE, the children will look at Islam. The children will consider, what is the Qur'an and what messages does it hold for Muslims. |
| | In Science, the children will investigate the three different states of water and how we can change the different states. |
