This term our theme is **Superstructures!**

English	This week we will be independently writing a persuasive letter to our teachers, persuading them that we should go on a trip to a famous superstructure! We will then be demonstrating everything we have learnt this term in our reading and grammar assessments.
Mathematics	In maths this week, we will be using compact column subtraction independently before solving one and two-step addition and subtraction word problems. At the end of the week, we will be completing a maths assessment based on perimeter and addition and subtraction.
Topic	In topic, we will be locating famous UK superstructures on a map and using the atlas index to find major UK cities. We will also be completing our superstructure prints. In science, we will be investigating how and why shadows change size throughout the day.

Please note that our weekly spelling test will take place on Tuesday instead of Monday this week.

It is essential that PE kits continue to come in on a Monday and go home on a Friday. If your child comes home in their PE kit, please can you ensure it comes back in the next day (it doesn't need to be washed, just bagged up).
