| English     | This week we will be looking at newspaper reports. We will be identifying the purpose, structure and key features of newspaper reports. We will go on to look at what quotes are and how they are used and punctuated within newspaper reports.   |
| Mathematics | In maths this week, we will be introduced to the grid method and how we can use it to help us solve multiplication questions involving a 2-digit or 3-digit number. At the end of the week, we will be solving scaling problems, using the grid method to help us.  |

We will learn techniques for building our own superstructures as well as developing our team work and problem solving skills. In science, we will be learning about the dangers of the sun and how we can protect ourselves from harmful UV rays. |
