Dear Parents/Carers,

This term our theme is **Superstructures**.

English	This week we will be editing, checking and publishing our newspaper reports so that we are ensuring they are the best they can be! We will then be identifying our stars and wishes from our highlighting. At the end of the week, we will discover that the Heights has had a VERY unusual visitor and will be reporting on the event for our big write. Please note that our spelling test this week will take place on Wednesday.
Mathematics	In maths this week, we will be looking at fractions. We will be counting in halves, quarters and tenths before going on to order fractions with the same denominator. At the end of the week, we will be adding fractions to make a whole.
Topic	In DT we will be identifying and testing different ways of strengthening a bridge. In science, we will be starting our 'Plants' unit and this week we will be learning about the different parts of plants and the jobs that they do. We will be completing our 'Changing Me' topic in PSHE. We will be learning how babies grow, how our bodies change inside and outside and what different families look like.

PE for Year 3 will continue to take place on **Tuesday** and **Wednesday** afternoons. It is essential that PE kits continue to come in on a Monday and go home on a Friday. If your child comes home in their PE kit, please can you ensure it comes back in the next day (it doesn't need to be washed, just bagged up).
